2017 Doctors of BC Health Authority Engagement Survey Report & Supplemental Report

The Survey was conducted by Accreditation Canada (AC), an affiliate of Health Standards Organization (HSO) from April 1 to 30, 2017. The intent of the survey is to seek the views of Doctors of BC members regarding their engagement and interaction with health authorities. The purpose of the supplemental report is to provide physicians and health authorities with site-specific data in an effort to improve collaboration and engagement. This is the second annual survey; the same 9 questions from Health Standards Organization's Worklife Pulse Tool were asked last year.
