Education in the Central Okanagan prides itself in the quality and standard of its education, all the way from Kindergarten to University level.

The Fraser Institute rankings, which include 983 public and independent schools, has ranked three Okanagan schools with a 10 out of 10: **A perfect score**. With 2 others in the top 100! These include Aberdeen Hall, Holy Cross, Our Lady of Lourdes, Kelowna Christian, and Anne McClymont.¹

Public Schools
