Child and Youth Mental Health Support Through Compass

BC Children's Hospital Compass is a new service for providers who are supporting children and youth (0-25 years old) with mental health and substance use concerns. When a community care provider calls for a consultation, they receive access to a multi-disciplinary team that includes child and youth psychiatrists, mental health and substance use clinicians and a care coordinator.

The team can help with diagnostic clarification, medication recommendations, treatment planning, consultation around cognitive behavioural therapy, dialectical behaviour therapy, substance use counselling, behavioral issues, family issues, trauma treatment, etc., and provide general support when things aren't going well. Peer Mentoring in KB Supported by PSP
