IH's MyHealthPortal is expanding!

Since launching the portal in June 2016, over 43,000 patients have enrolled to have 24-hour secure online access to their IH lab results, medical imaging reports, visit history, and certain appointment details and instructions. The portal is now expanding to include additional clinical reports.
