








Finding Specialists using the 'Areas of Practice' Tab

Want to quickly find a specialist who provides a specific service without having to search through the filter list for that specialty? You can use the 'Areas of Practice' search tab to narrow down results with just a click! This is a particularly effective way to quickly look for specialists that provide services which cross a number of specialty areas.



Search for an area of practice or procedure in the search bar (eg. allergy testing). Then narrow your search to 'Areas of Practice'.


