ABOUT THE ROLE

Board members attend in-person meetings (no more than once a month), the Annual General Meeting (AGM), and other Division events throughout the year. Responsibilities include:

- Committing to the Division's Vision, Mission, and Strategic Initiatives
- Leading the Division and its committees in setting and monitoring annual goals
- · Providing budget oversight
- Ensuring effective two-way communication with members, partners, and other stakeholders
- Overseeing sound risk management practices

The term of office for Community Member Directors is three years, with the possibility of consecutive terms. The position is paid.
