Partnering with people affected by substance use, to live their life in all its fullness by recognizing the person as the author of their own story with a lifetime of rich and diverse experiences.

Mission

ICMT is an inter-disciplinary, outreach team that practices from a harm reduction, strengths-based philosophy and provides individual care to adults who are actively using substances. ICMT respects and acknowledges personal differences and promotes a focus on the assets and abilities of the person and their environment.

The ICMT in the Comox Valley is focused on providing services to people who are:

- *19 years of age; and*
- *Experiencing moderate to severe impacts in their daily functioning due to substance use; and*
- *Experience multiple barriers related to housing, poverty, accessing health and appropriate services;*
- *May have regularly involvement with emergency services including the legal system*

People partnering with ICMT require more intensive services than are available in the traditional mental health and substance use system of care.

ICMT services will include street outreach and providing services in the community, meeting people where they are to be found. Individuals will be engaged by a multi-disciplinary team, integrating with other direct community and health care services to support people and families in the Comox Valley region.
