- Looking for ways to enhance your practice while working from home?
 Divisions have put together a list of ideas in this Practice Enhancement
 Opportunities and Supports during COVID-19 document available here.
- Physician Quarantine Leave Funding Doctors of BC has communicated
 that if you are quarantined for being COVID-positive or COVID-exposed,
 the DoBC no longer requires a letter of support from a senior health
 authority person or MHO. That letter can be supplied by a Department

- If your EMR does not allow you to send faxes with a wet signature, consider
 adding SR Fax (www.srfax.com) which integrates with the EMR and will
