

ENJOY YOURSELF — WALKS & HIKES UNIQUE TO NANAIMO

Top recommendations:

- Neck Point Park Located off Hammond Bay road, you will see signs. Beautiful walk along ocean, prettiest most popular walk for everyone. Embedded map: https://goo.gl/maps/QxYeV
- Maffeo Sutton Park Located downtown, come walk Nanaimo's waterfront promenade and become a part of our local culture. Look out for the Silly Boat Regatta or Dragon Boat Festival while you are there! Embedded map: https://goo.gl/maps/0KvFL
- New Castle Island Marine Provincial Park –5 minute ferry ride from Maffeo Sutton Park. Great for families, bicycling, picnics and camping! Official site: http://www.newcastleisland.ca/

Casual walks (can be made short or long):

- Pipers Lagoon Located off Hammond Bay road, much the same as Neck Point Park. Very pretty along one of Nanaimo's most beautiful beaches. Embedded map: https://goo.gl/maps/L38he
- Linley Valley (Cottle Lake Park) Entrances off Rock City Road or Hammond Bay Road, nice wooded trails around Cottle Lake. Embedded map: https://goo.gl/maps/Fqz6t
- Bowen Park Located off Bowen Road, a series of trails along the Millstone River. Don't forget

- Westwood Lake Park Located in foothills of Mount Benson, nice well-groomed loop with an off-leash dog are on far side of lake. Embedded map: https://goo.gl/maps/ihNHY

Dog off-leash walks:

- Cable Bay Located off Cedar Road, the best-off leash dog walk to tire out your pup! Continue right when you reach the bottom for a chance to see sea lions or even orcas swimming through Dodd Narrows. Embedded map: https://goo.gl/maps/0UOQ8
- Colliery Dam Located off Nanaimo Lakes Road, upper lake parking lot access to off-leash (non-fenced) trails. Lower dam dogs must be leashed. Embedded map: https://goo.gl/maps/mhpJl
