Reminder from Delta Hospital and the Emergency Department

- 1. **Pregnant patients over 20 weeks** needing assessment should be presenting to the birthing unit where they will deliver, not to the emergency department.
- 2. Sub-specialist referrals Delta Hospital has on site hospitalists, internal medicine and general and orthopedic surgery services. If you have any other consultant service you wish patients to follow up with, please refer the patient to that consultant's primary hospital unless specific arrangements have been made with the consultant and Delta Hospital.
- 3. **Outpatient transfusions & IV antibiotics** Delta ER hosts outpatient transfusions and IV antibiotics for patients with a geographic address in Delta. Due to capacity constraints, patients with an address outside of Delta will be referred to their closest hospital site. If you have a patient who resides in Delta and is in need of transfusion or IV antibiotics, the ER staff will be happy to discuss arrangements over the phone.

Physician Office Security
