Clinical Frailty Scale

The Clinical Frailty Scale (CFS) was introduced as a way to summarize the overall level of fitness or frailty of an older adult after they had been evaluated by an experienced clinician. It quickly evolved for clinical use, and has been widely taken up as a judgement-based tool to screen for frailty and to broadly stratify degrees of fitness and frailty. Used around the world, there are many resources listed on the Dalhousie University website.
