



WHAT IS A DISASTER FIRST AID STATION (DFAS)?

A DFAS is a medical clinic in the Comox Valley that has agreed to provide first aid and basic medical care to the public in the event of a major disaster.



WHEN AND HOW ARE THEY ACTIVATED?

The medical clinic assumes the role as a DFAS upon request of the Comox Valley Emergency Program (CVEP) or if the need is very clear, such as after a severe earthquake.



HOW MANY DFAS CLINICS ARE THERE?

Currently there are 6 DFAS clinics (see list and map). These clinics were chosen based on their seismic resilience, geographic location, closeness to a pharmacy and ability to respond in a crisis. Other clinics may be added in the future.

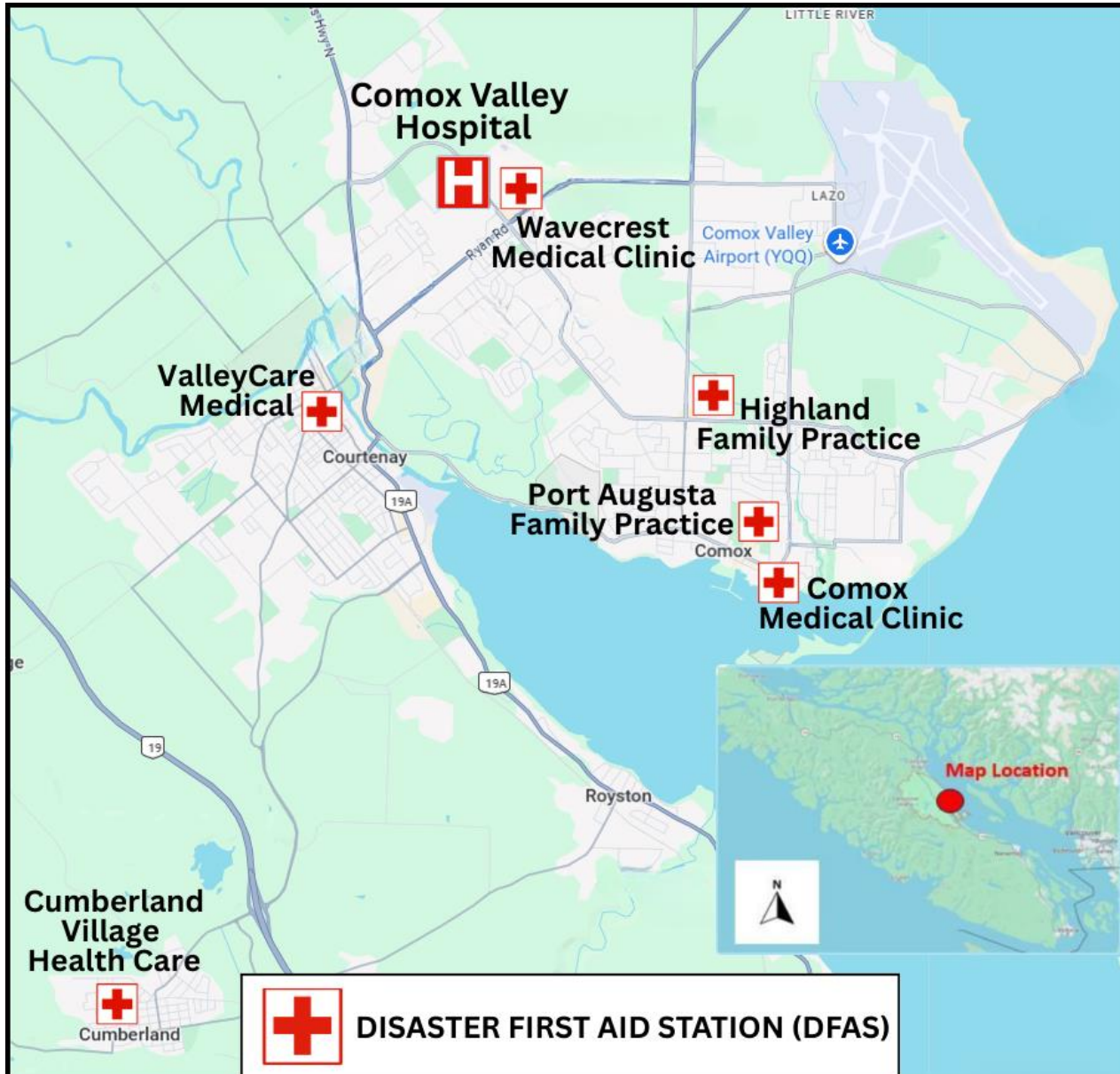
