Ethical Recruitment Principles

By participating in the Division's recruitment program, recruiting clinics, physician candidates, and the Nanaimo Division agree to abide by the principles detailed below.

Recruitment Principles

- 1. Be respectful of those with whom you are engaging; includes providing timely responses and arriving at meetings on time.
- 2. Provide all communication, including any changes, accurately, fully, and in a timely manner.
- 3. Ensure personal information, clinic details, interactions, and outcomes are kept confidential.
- 4. Maintain regular communication between all parties regarding the recruitment status.
- 5. The Division will:
 - a. provide contact information and candidate CVs to recruiting clinics upon consent from the candidate:
 - b. treat all recruiting clinics and candidates in a professional and fair manner; collect feedback to make informed decisions;
 - c. promote cooperation between recruiting clinics, communities, candidates, and divisions for mutual benefit;
 - d. Maintain confidentiality with recruiting clinics, communities, candidates.

6. The recruiting clinic will:

- a. ensure their advert accurately reflects their clinic, including both positive and negative aspects;
- b. share remuneration and special compensation arrangements accurately, fully, and in a timely manner, for mutual understanding of expectations and commitments;
- c. be responsible for verification of a candidate's license, qualifications, references, and general "fit" for the clinic. NOTE: Health Match BC verifies licensure of applications that have been processed by Health Match BC.

7. The candidate will:

- a. disclose experience, education, qualifications, licensure status, clinic intentions, and anything else that could impact the recruitment decision;
- b. inform all parties of pending or active complaints registered with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC;
- c. disclose if they are considering other opportunities or have commitments with other clinics within or outside the community (high-level only, no details).
