Provincial Attachment System

- Upcoming PAS changes to enhance patient attachment

The Ministry of Health on April 17th launched enhancements to the Provincial Attachment System (PAS) and the Health Connect Registry (HCR) to help improve and accelerate patient attachment while reducing the burden on physicians.

For physicians: Through the PAS System Attachment Coordinators will use the new data to recommend a list of patients for possible attachment with physicians who have capacity to expand their panels, taking into account complexity, any recent changes, and length of time on the HCR. Physicians will be able to build a panel with varying degrees of complexity and health care needs. For the first time, physicians will be able to receive, select, and attach patients entirely through the PAS.
