The Port Alberni Primary Care Network is actively seeking leased spaces that are easily renovated for the development of a Community Health Centre

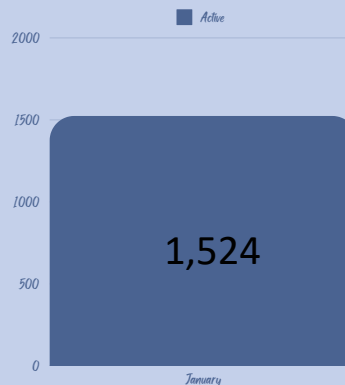

Active Cases on Health Connect Registry

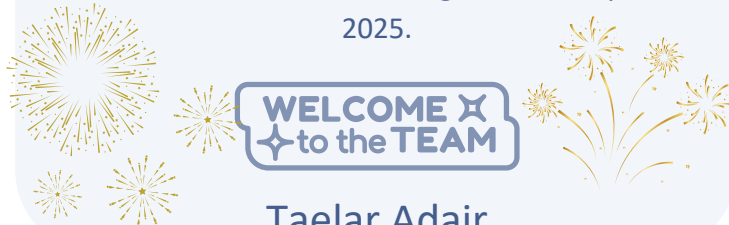

MOA Corner Transferring patients using the PAS

Family physicians can now use the Provincial Attachment System (PAS) to transfer patients between physicians or clinics. This feature is especially helpful for physicians retiring, leaving a clinic, or needing to reassign patients to the correct panel.

What Physicians Need to Know:

- The Panel Transfer tab is available on the PAS Home page and the My Panel page.
- To transfer a patient, the sending physician must use the receiving physician's MSP Practitioner Number.
- The receiving physician can accept or decline requests on a patient-by-patient basis.
- Multiple patients can be transferred at once, with options to search by name or Personal Health Number (PHN) for individual transfers, or transfer an entire panel at once.
- Physicians can delegate the transfer process to non-clinical staff by completing the endorsement process.
