Bio for Dr Howard Davidson

Dr Howard Davidson graduated from the University of Cape Town, MBChB, in 1990. He worked in a variety of medical disciplines from 1991 to 1994 obtaining post graduate diplomas in Obstetrics, Anaesthesia and Child Health from the College of Medicine of South Africa.

He worked and travelled in Canada, UK and New Zealand working in Family Practice, Surgery and Anaesthesia from 1994 to 1996. He returned to South Africa in 1996 and worked in Family Practice obtaining his MCFP(SA) in 1998.

He returned to Canada specifically, Quesnel,BC, and worked as a rural Family Doctor from 1999 to 2002 providing general medical, ER, obstetric and anaesthesia care to the people of Quesnel and surrounds. He obtained his CCFP status during this time. He relocated to Kelowna in 2002 and became a partner at Spall Medical Clinic providing family practice services. It was during this time he developed an interest in addiction medicine and started opioid agonist treatment to a group of patients. In 2007, Dr Davidson started the Kingsfoil Medical Clinic with Dr Alexis Thomson operating out of a heritage home in the downtown core. He continued to provide family practice care and addiction care and in 2010 certified in the USA as an addiction specialist. He continues to work in full-service family medicine and addiction medicine and has been certified by the College of Family Physicians of Canada as an Addiction Medicine specialist.

Dr Davidson has been and is actively involved in Kelowna community life having served on the board of Crossroads (a drug and alcohol rehabilitation center that used to operate in Kelowna). Until recently he served on the board of Kelowna's Gospel Mission. He is committed to his local church. He is a member of the Alpine Club of Canada.

Dr Davidson enjoys a variety of activities that are available in the Okanagan and include trail running, mountain biking, rock climbing and various forms of skiing. He is married to Gil and they have three adult children.
