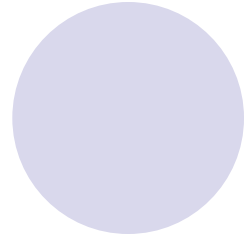
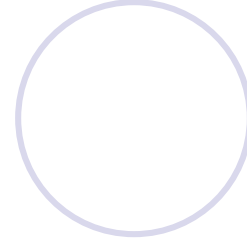
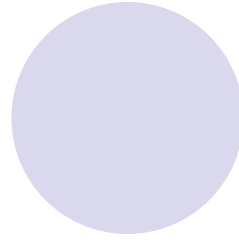
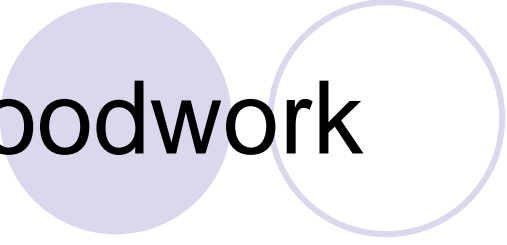
The Pap test is a good test because

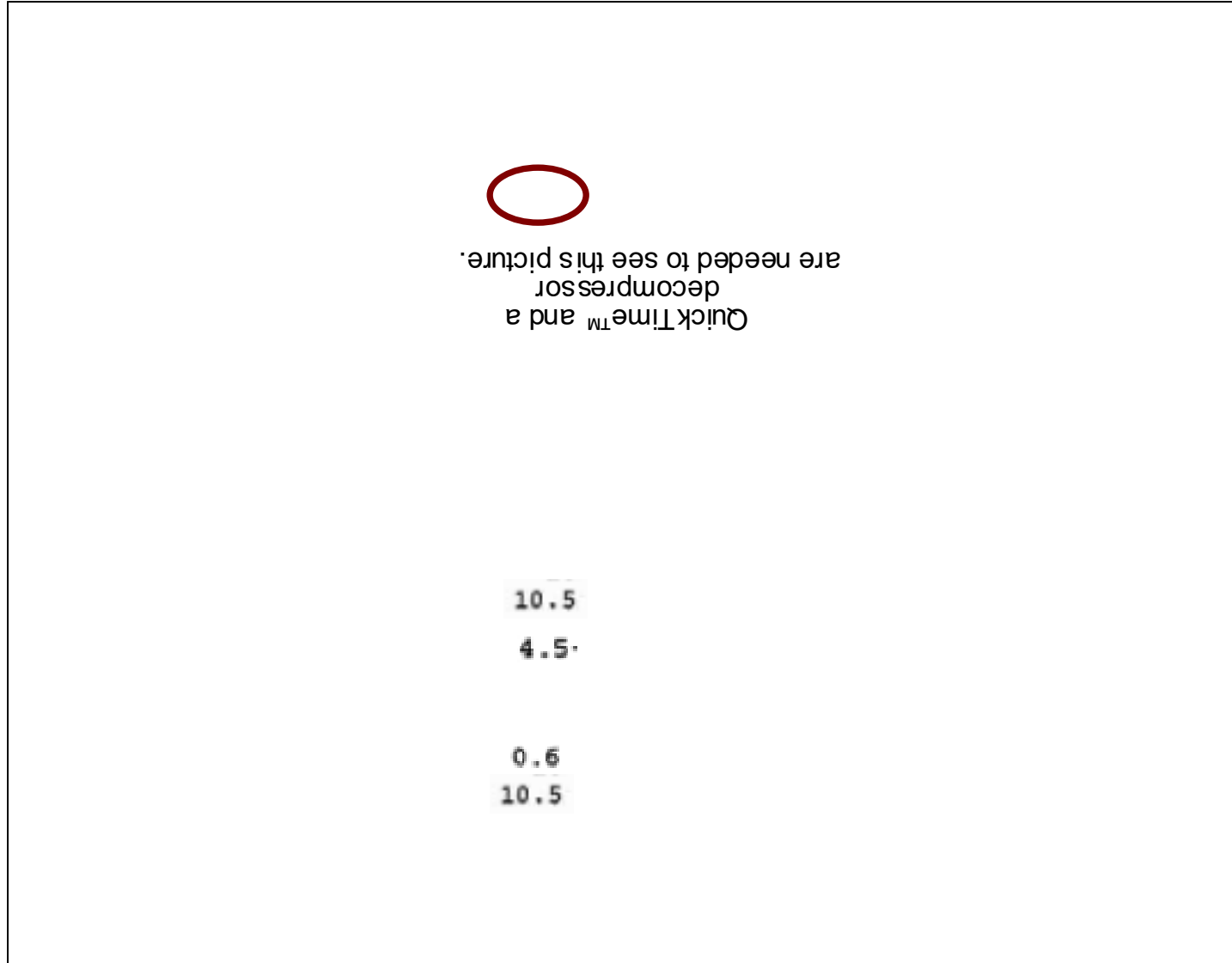

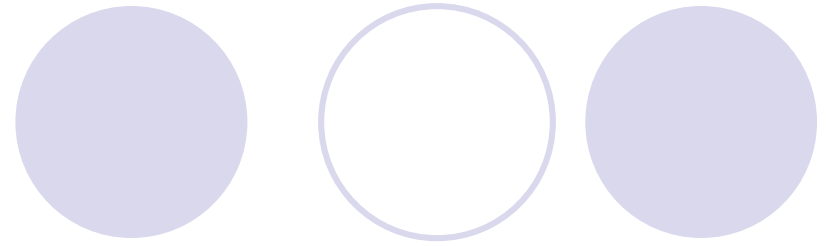


Framingham Risk Score



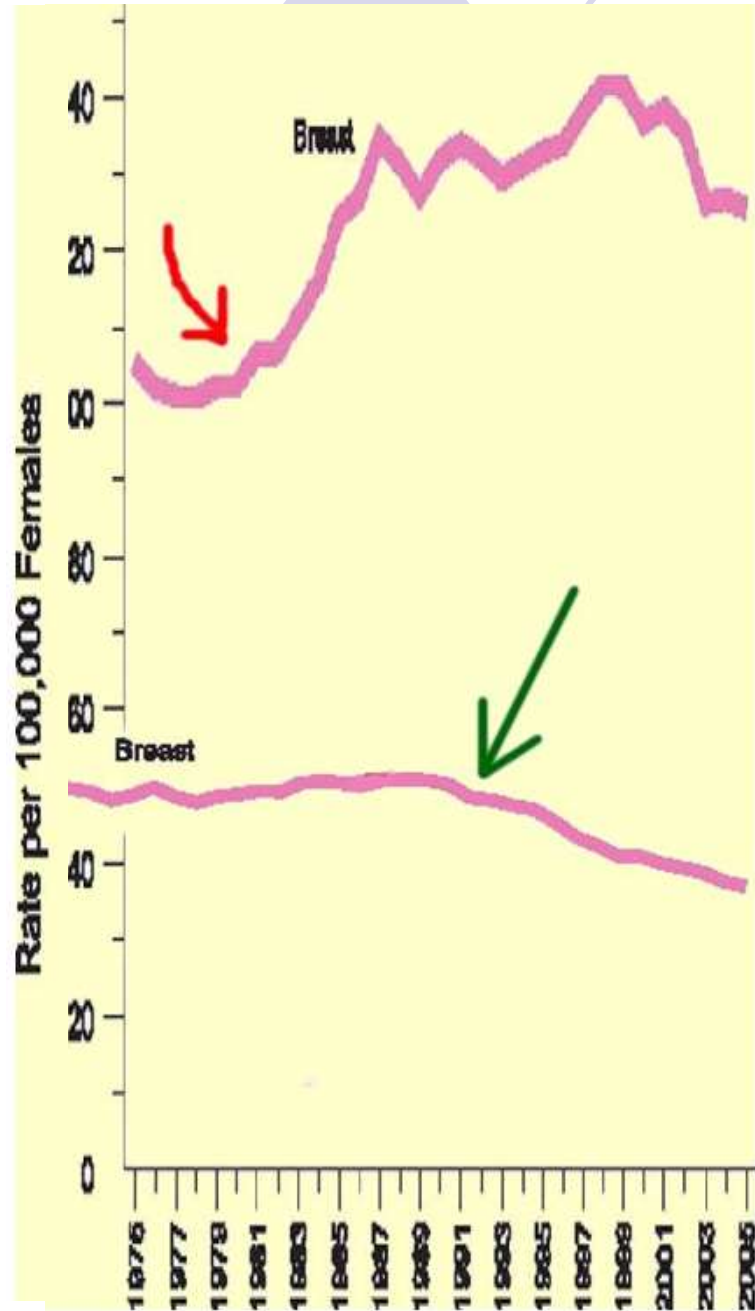

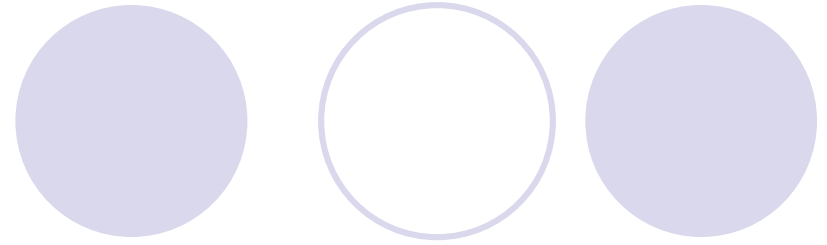




Colon cancer prevention

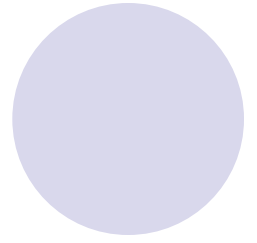
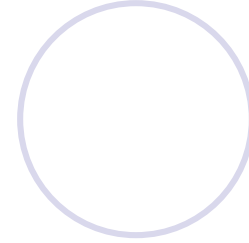
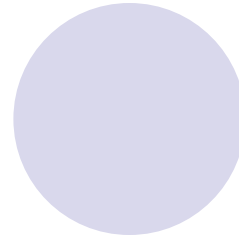
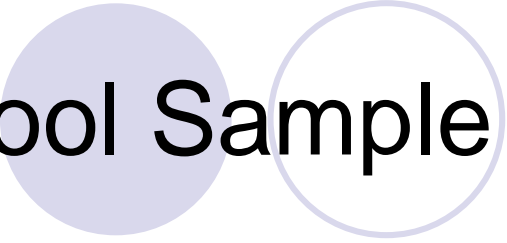
- Everyone: watch out for bowel changes

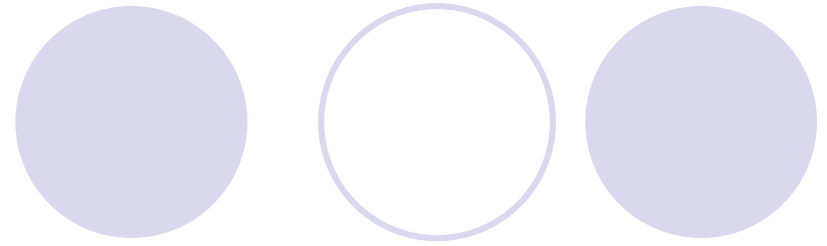

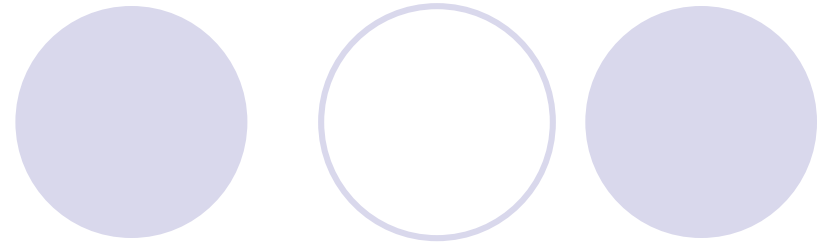
