INFORMATION ON INDIAN RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL (IRS) PROGRAM

Who is eligible to receive services?

> FORMER IRS STUDENTS

- All former IRS students, regardless of the individual's status, who have:
 - received or are eligible to receive CEP or
 - o who are resolving their claim against Canada through IAP, and/or
 - o are participating in TRC or Commemorative events

> FAMILY MEMBERS OF FORMER IRS STUDENTS

- defined as spouse/partner
- o those raised by or raised in the household of a former IRS student, and
- any relations who have experienced effects of intergenerational trauma associated with an eligible family member's time at an Indian Residential School

> TRC PARTICIPANTS (National and Community Events)

 Anyone who attends a TRC event is eligible to access support from an RHSW or a counsellor before, during and after the event
