**Delta Hospital CT Scanner Replacement**

The Delta Hospital CT scanner will be replaced starting September 30, 2019.

From **September 30 to December 7, 2019**, a Mobile CT scanner will be parked on-site to support urgent/emergent cases. From **October 14<sup>th</sup> until December 6<sup>th</sup>**, only inpatients, emergency patients, and urgent outpatients will be scanned on the mobile scanner.

From **October 14<sup>th</sup> to December 6<sup>th</sup>**, semi-urgent outpatients should be referred to an alternate site, such as PAH or JPOCSC.
