SGP BILLING ALERT: PUNCH AND SHAVE BIOPSIES - CHANGE TO BILLING FEES

Effective May 1st, punch and shave biopsies which require sutures may now be billed under fees **13600 or 13601** Biopsy of skin or mucosa.

A major tray fee **00090** is billable in addition.

For punch and shave biopsies that do not require sutures, continue to bill as an age appropriate office visit fee 0100 series.
