



## **ASPEN MATERNITY AND WOMEN'S HEALTH CLINIC**

At Aspen Maternity we are proud to be involved with teaching the next generation of doctors. We have two types of learners at our site:

**Medical Students** - these are students who have completed an undergraduate degree and are now in their 3rd year of medical school. During this year they will rotate through all of the core areas of medicine. Students are closely supervised and you will always be seen by one of our doctors as well.

**Family Practice Residents** - these are doctors who have completed medical school and are now in their residency, or specialty training. Some of our residents are at the beginning of their training and some will soon be fully qualified family doctors. Residents are supervised according to their level of experience; more senior residents can see patients fully on their own. However, all patients are discussed with one of our maternity doctors to ensure that a high level of care is maintained.
