BC Pharmacists can assess & prescribe for 21 minor ailments (including uncomplicated urinary tract infections, allergies & more), contraception, nicotine cessation & emergency refills. Book an appointment or walk-in to an available pharmacy.

The Virtual Doctor of the Day program is open to all First Nations people & their families living in BC. The program includes doctors of Indigenous ancestry. All doctors & allied health care professionals are trained to follow the principles & practices of cultural safety & humility. Preventive Screening

> KB SCREENING CLINIC

A virtual clinic offering age-related routine screening for Kootenay Boundary residents who don't currently have a primary care provider. Screen for colon, breast, cervical & lung cancer as well as abdominal aortic aneurysm, HIV & syphilis.
