

# New Form | Medical Imaging Acute Transfer Pathway

The aim of the form is to define the patient care pathway, when transferring from rural to regional sites for acute diagnostic imaging, to reduce gaps in the process and to benefit patients and teams.

The form is accessed by the Physician at the rural site and follows the patient throughout the transfer.



- MRP at the rural site completes form with the patient care plan
- Copy kept on file at rural site
- Original form is attached to patient documentation, and provided to BCAS paramedics for transfer

- Receives form with patient documentation from MRP / Nurse
- Reviews plan
- Calls receiving site at 20 minutes away

- Receives form from BCAS paramedics and reviews to inform their work
- Patient receives medical imaging and then:
  - a) Returns to sending site via BCAS
  - b) Continues to ED

- ED Physician will receive the form if the patient is:
  - a) Admitted to ED for further care / specialist consult
  - b) Brought to ED to await return transport (not admitted)
