NEW Chronic Pain Tools for Your Daily Clinical Practice

Check out these new tools to support chronic pain patients:

Chronic Pain Roadmap: Supports Family Practitioners in creating ongoing self-management plans for chronic pain patients.

Coaching for Health: Pain BC's free telephone or video conference lay coaching program, designed to help people living with pain learn self-management skills, regain function and improve their well-being.

RISE BC's Self-management Manual: Comprehensive manual written by Dr. Joel Kailia at RISE BC for motivated patients to fully understand and develop the capacity/skills to better manage their pain. Over 300 pages of information, tips, and tools.

Specialist Access: Use MBMD, RACE and Telehealth Virtual health supports include:

MBMD secure messaging – Use <u>smart phone</u> or <u>desktop</u> <u>computer</u> to direct message specialists, provide important details and add triage information for time appropriate specialist consults. *Need help with MBMD? Contact Mona Mattei* - <u>mmattei@divisionsbc.ca</u>

Rapid Access to Consultative Expertise – For rapid (within 2hrs) consults, call 1-844-365-7223 or create a RACE message through MBMD.

Telehealth – Multiple departments now provide telehealth services to patients. Your patient may not have to travel to Nelson, Trail, Kelowna or Vancouver. Add "Please consider telehealth for this consult if it is available" to your referral letters. Trail/Nelson departments offering Telehealth include: maternity care, urology, internal medicine, general surgery, anesthesiology, and pediatrics.
