The Yúustway Health & Wellness Centre (Kal'numet Primary Care Clinic), located on Squamish Nation reserve near Parkroyal Shopping Centre is urgently looking for a GP to work in clinic 2.5 days a week. Either as a locum, or multiple locums working half days, or a GP in a .5 FTE PCN contracted position. The clinic currently operates 5 days a week with Physicians, Naturopathic Physician, Nurse Practitioner and Public Health Nurses.

The clinic does have flexibility when filling the locum shifts. They could be covered by either one physician or five, each working a half day. While in-person services are desired, virtual consultation is an option. Payment for these shifts will be at the current DOBC sessional hourly rate, with the option of stepping into the PCN .5 FTE contract if desired. We do ask for a minimum 3 month commitment to support relationship development.

Kal'numet Primary Care Clinic is in need of GP's with a strong interest in First Nations health care. Interested physicians should be experienced in providing Culturally safe and informed medical care. We see this as an exciting opportunity for GP's wishing to expand their panels with the First Nations population.

The GP should be interested in working in a team format alongside nurses, mental health workers, Elders and Traditional Healers. You should also be able to prescribe OAT or at minimum, ready to quickly step into the funded training currently available to learn how to prescribe OAT. The Kal'numet Primary Care Clinic can help interested physicians walk through the process of becoming an OAT Prescriber.
