Effective primary care coverage is essential during the COVID-19 outbreak and expanding virtual care will allow physicians to provide care remotely and limit the possibility of transmission. To accommodate increasing requests for immediate support, the Doctors Technology Office (DTO) will be holding webinars, publishing resources and providing direct supports including:
