About PracticeinBC.ca

<u>PracticeinBC.ca</u> is a recruitment and retention portal site with two parts: one has information for people interested in being a family doctor in BC and the other has tools for divisions seeking new family doctors for their communities.

Benefits for divisions and local family doctors

<u>PracticeinBC.ca</u> is a portal site created by the Divisions of Family Practice Recruitment and Retention Steering Committee, with support from GPSC, to assist local divisions in attracting and retaining family doctors.
