## **BACKGROUND: GPSC PROVINCIAL RESIDENTIAL CARE INITIATIVE**

Residential care is at a crossroads with a deficit in the number of GPs interested in caring for its increasing number of frail patients. The General Practice Services Committee's (GPSC) provincial <u>Residential Care Initiative</u> (RCI) supports Divisions to create a local program to optimize residential care by family physicians based on meeting best practice expectations and tracking intended outcomes:

#### Best practice expectations:

- 24/7 availability and on-site attendance, when required
- Proactive visits to residents
- · Meaningful medication reviews
- Completed documentation
- Attendance at case conferences

### System level outcomes:

- Reduced unnecessary or inappropriate hospital transfers
- Improved patient-provider experience
- Reduced cost/patient as a result of higher quality of care

The Division has been consulting with members, residential care facilities and VCH to create a local program that supports family physicians to optimize care of





### RICHMOND'S RESIDENTIAL CARE INITIATIVE PROGRAM

Below is an overview of the GP best practice requirements and supportive services as part of Richmond's Residential Care Initiative program.

### Richmond's requirement for: 24/7 availability and on-site attendance when required

### Daytime availability:

- GPs participating in Richmond's Residential Care Initiative (called RCI GPs) will provide care to their own patients from 07:00- 17:00 Mon Fri
- RCI GPs will respond to facilities for urgent matters within 2 hours (or in-person if necessary)

### After hours call:

- All RCI GPs will participate in the call group
- 1 GP will provide call coverage for RCI patients between the hours of 17:00 and 07:00
- On call for 1 week at a time (Mon 1700 Mon 0700)
- Use of centralized call service
- Standardized summary sheet to be implemented across facilities to support RCI GP and facility staff communication

## Richmond's requirement for: Proactive visits

- Minimum 1 visit per quarter (3 months) per patient
- Effective case conferences and medication reviews are also types of proactive visits
- Clustering of GPs to facilities to increase availability to attend (minimum of 5 to maximum of 50 beds per RCI GP, per facility in order to access available RCI payments)

## Richmond's requirement for: Meaningful medication reviews

- On admission and then every 6 months
- In person or by telephone through scheduled visit
- Preferably done so alongside the pharmacist

#### Richmond's requirement for: Completed documentation

- Documentation of visits and communications
- · Advanced care planning would include MOST and incorporate patient and family preferences at end-of-life

### Richmond's requirement for: Attendance at case conferences

- On admission (< 4-6 weeks) and annually thereafter
- RCI GP to attend in person or by tele- or video- conference
- . Supports include clustering of GPs to facilities, stacking case conferences and dedicated physician parking

### **Additional RCI Program Supports**

- Clustering of GPs to facilities
- Mentorship of new physicians in the community to join the RCI program
- Attendance at a minimum of two educational events per year
- · Resources on the relevant billing codes
- Through a provincial process, the GPSC will provide monitoring information on the five best practice expectations and three system level outcomes for quality improvement purposes. For example, is there 24/7 availability across facilities, what level of proactive visiting is occurring as reported through fee for service, etc.

## **RCI Funding**

- The RCI is supported through new funding from GPSC to Divisions who are charged with administering payment once services have been delivered
- RCI GPs who commit to meeting the five best practices are eligible to receive a \$200 per bed stipend and a separate incentive for on call (weighted to reward those that cover for peak holiday periods; weekly amount dependent upon number of participating RCI GPs)
- RCI payments are in addition to current MSP FFS remuneration
- RCI GPs will need to have at least 5 residents per facility to receive RCI payments for residents in that facility. RCI GPs may care for more than 50 residents at each facility but will only receive RCI payments for up to 50 residents per facility.
- Total annual compensation cannot exceed the \$45,000 limit per physician stipulated by GPSC
- Once a physician has opted into the RCI program, best practice expectations must be met at each facility, with a brief Letter of Agreement signed at each site
