Richmond is a dynamic and ethnically diverse community of around 200,000 and is the fourth largest city in British Columbia. Richmond enjoys a temperate west coast climate and does not experience extreme temperatures and weather conditions like other parts of Canada. Because of Richmond's distance from the mountains, our average rainfall is 30% less than Vancouver's. With the coastal mountain range as a backdrop, Richmond is only 20 minutes from Downtown Vancouver, 25 minutes from the US border and is the home to Vancouver's International airport and is a major transportation hub for Metro Vancouver.

As a recent venue for the 2010 Winter Olympic Games, Richmond has been experiencing growth and change developing into a highly livable, cosmopolitan city, with many restaurants, shopping centres and entertainment facilities. The City is known for its charming seaside village of Steveston (where you can buy fresh fish or have it cooked for you), Asian summer night markets, and Richmond Olympic Oval, a world class fitness facility for elite sport training and competition and also community services. The Canada Line offers convenient access to Richmond and Metro Vancouver attractions, while the 80 km of biking and walking trails connecting beaches, parks and neighoburhods makes it easy to enjoy the recreational opportunities and natural beauty Richmond has to offer.

Housing in Richmond – Richmond is comprised of diverse neighbourhoods with a variety of housing options that include single family homes, town homes, condominiums, coach houses, apartments and suites. One can choose to live in a suburban neighbourhood or in the City Centre, which has experienced a rapid development of high-rise condominiums and apartments near transit, amenities and services.

French Immersion Programs - Designed for students whose first language is not French, this bilingual education program is open to all Richmond students. Between Kindergarten and Grade 12, students follow the regular BC curriculum.

Strong Start Programs – are free drop-in early learning programs that promote growth

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and development in all areas for preschoolaged children. Parents/caregivers attend these programs with their children and are linked to community agencies and services if needed.

Post-Secondary - Richmond is home to Kwantlen Polytechninc University College campus and British Columbia Institute of Technology (BCIT) Aerospace Technology Campus. It lies close to the University of British Columbia and is a short ferry-ride to the University of Victoria.

Parks and recreation – Richmond's extensive recreation programs and services and bounty of outdoor recreational opportunities all contribute to a healthy active community and help to enhance the quality of life.

Recreation and Community Centres – Richmond has an abundance of modern recreation facilities, including: 8 community centres, 2 ice arenas, 2 aquatic centres, and 2 outdoor pools. Richmond is home to the Richmond Country Club and the Richmond Olympic Oval – a multi-use facility and international centre of excellence for sports, health and wellness, culture and entertainment.

Speech Language Services For Children 0-5 Yrs	Speech-Language Pathologists (S-LPs) use a variety of activities to help children learn new speech and language skills. During the first appointment, the S- LP will evaluate how well a child is talking and listening. The S-LP looks at: pronunciation, how well the tongue and lips move, how children understand and use language, and if there any voice, hearing, or stuttering problems. Anyone who has concerns about a child's speech, language, voice or fluency can refer the child to their speech and language services, with the parents' consent. These services are free-of-charge. Children entering kindergarten will be seen by a S- LP at their school. After referral, a S-LP will assess each child. 
