
Clearwater, nestled in BC's North Thompson Valley, 125 km north of Kamloops and 6 hours from Vancouver, offers year-round recreational activities including world-class kayaking, backcountry skiing, and hiking. Surrounded by the majestic Wells Gray Mountains, it's a vibrant, outdoor-loving community with a strong sense of togetherness and a family-friendly atmosphere.

Wells Gray Park boasts stunning vistas, deep canyons, volcanic cones, old-growth forests, and white-water rivers. The peaceful lifestyle is perfect for young families and those seeking a slower pace, with amenities like education, healthcare, and recreation.

Clearwater's five physicians provide full-service medical care to a population of around 5,000, which increases during the summer tourism season. Primary care is provided by physician-owned Wells Gray Medical Clinic. At nearby Dr. Helmcken Memorial Hospital, physicians provide emergency and in-patient services, sharing a 1:5 call schedule.
