### ***What We Offer:***


Airportway Medical Clinic boasts a team of 5 family physicians who provide 24/7 care between the clinic and Fort Nelson General Hospital.

- Airportway Medical Clinic is open Mon-Fri, 9am-5pm.
- Fort Nelson General Hospital open 24/7 with a rotating on-call schedule.
- Fort Nelson General Hospital has 15 acute and 7 LTC beds, on-site lab, ultrasound, x-ray, pharmacy, and point-of-care testing.
