

Hazelton

You will find Hazelton in the Upper Skeena Region under the towering cliffs of Sdikyoodenax mountain where the Skeena and Bulkley Rivers meet. Upstream from the confluence, a suspension bridge spans the Bulkley River Canyon in Hagwilget and provides a spectacular landmark. The majority of the population is of Indigenous descent, and with eight First Nations Village spread throughout the region there is a wealth of history and culture to explore.


Hazelton is located at the northernmost point of Highway 16 (between Terrace and Smithers) and is a mecca for outdoor enthusiasts with world renowned river fishing, gorgeous lakes, hiking trails and endless forests all located on the unceded traditional territory of the Gitxsan people. Hazelton offers intellectually stimulating work with supportive colleagues in a team-based environment with fantastic support staff under an alternate payment program (APP) with rural incentives.

Our members are privileged to provide medical services on the traditional and unceded territories of the Gitxsan Nation, which include the Gitanmaax, Gitsegukla, Sik-e-Dakh, Kispiox, and Gitanyow First Nations, and the Wet'suwet'en Nation, which include the Hagwilget First Nations.
