RE: Vernon Downtown Lab – Sterling Center – Walk-in service Closure

Due to continuing staff shortages, the Vernon Downtown Lab – Sterling Center will be closed to walk-in services until further notice. The Sterling Center Lab will continue to provide lab collection services by appointment only. Appointments can be made by visiting www.labonlinebooking.ca as well as by calling I-877-740-7747 between 8 AM and 7 PM. We encourage all patients who do not require urgent blood work to utilize our appointment system. We are currently booking appointments with a 2-3 week lead time.

For those patients that require lab collection in a more urgent manner, walk-in service is available at Vernon Jubilee Hospital – Polson Tower Lab, Monday-Friday 0730 – 1600. Please note that walk-in wait times vary and due to COVID-19 safety restrictions patients may be asked to wait outside until their number is called if the waiting room is full.
