- Education group session
 - In person group classes
 - 2 days, each 1 ½ hours long
- 1:1 with a clinician for those who need individualized care
 - Dietitian
 - Pharmacist
 - Registered Nurse
- Glucometer strip training and certification for PharmaCare coverage
