GOALS

- To provide assessment, short-term intervention, and support to medically complex and frail seniors living in the community
- To provide timely and appropriate access to an interdisciplinary geriatric team
- To provide education and support to clients, families and caregivers

THE PROGRAM Interdisciplinary Approach to Comprehensive Geriatric Assessment

- Older Adult Intake to determine further clinical assessments
- Interdisciplinary shared care planning
- Individualized care that identifies client goals, interventions, and recommendations
- Short-term interventions as indicated
- The referring Family Physician or Nurse Practitioner is invited to be part of the interdisciplinary shared care plan



REFERRAL CRITERIA

- 65 years of age or older (under 65 by exception)
- Resides within Salmon Arm, Sicamous, Sorrento, Malakwa, Mara, Enderby and the Secwepemculecw Nation
- Medically complex or frail (at risk of decline without intervention)
- CSHS Clinical Frailty Scale of 4 6
- Potential to stabilize and/or optimize physical health and function
- Agreeable for assessment/intervention Geriatric Syndromes such as:
- More than 2 falls in the past year
- Increasing balance and mobility issues
- More than 2 Emergency Department visits in the past year
- Unintentional weight loss or dysphagia
- Sub-optimal pain control
- Medication management concerns
- Troublesome Incontinence
