

## **Treatment Services**

If you are ready to enter treatment for your opioid use, the following services are available to help you.

Unsure where to start or need support while you are waiting for treatment? Drop into the Connections Group Tuesdays and Fridays from 2:30-3:30pm at 1125 Pembroke Street to get support, information, and guidance in accessing services.

#### **Detox and Stabilization:**

You can self-refer to detox and stabilization by walking into VIHA Substance Use Services Intake at 1119 Pembroke Street daily between 9am and 8pm to begin the intake process.

# Opioid Agonist Treatment (Methadone and Suboxone):

The following clinics in Victoria will help you figure out if opioid agonist therapy is right for you and if so will help you start treatment.

## Supportive Recovery Housing

If you need of extra support with your recovery after stabilization, there are supportive recovery homes for males and females offered through Island Health (males and females) and Umbrella Society (males only). These homes offer a safe living situation with other people pursuing their recovery.
