

Board Director

Responsibilities

Duties of Director

Every Director will:

- (a) further and not hinder the purposes, aims and objects of the Society;
- (b) act honestly and in good faith with a view to the best interests of the society;
- (c) exercise the care, diligence and skill that a reasonably prudent individual would exercise in comparable circumstances;
- (d) act in accordance with *Societies Act*;
- (e) uphold the Constitution and comply with these Bylaws, the Regulations and the policies of the Society in effect from time to time; and
- (f) abide by such codes of conduct and ethics adopted by the Society.

Qualifications

- Experience working or collaborating with non-profit organizations, preference will be given to individuals that have been part of (or have led) a Board of Directors.
- Knowledge of the BC healthcare system.
- Healthcare planning
- Knowledge of the Surrey-North Delta community is preferred.
- Experience working in a primary healthcare setting or experience working with physicians and/or allied health care providers is an asset.
- Cultural awareness and competency.

Working conditions

- The board normally meets every 3rd Wednesday morning for a two-hour meeting at the Division office. (Because of Covid-19 the board has been having virtual bi-weekly 1-hour meetings instead).
- The board meets twice a year for a full day Board Retreat (typically Saturday or Sunday)
- The term of office of Directors will normally be three (3) years
