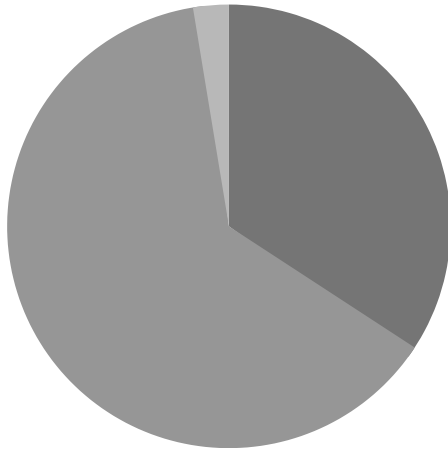

Respondents who agreed with the statement, "I feel confident in my understanding about recent advances in the treatment of my patients with O.C.D."

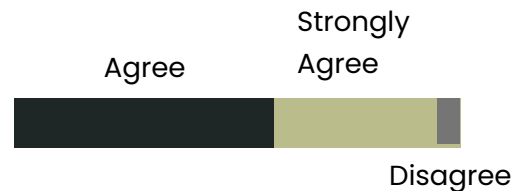
