Community Care Tip of the Month

A Provincial After Hours Palliative Nursing Service Telephone Support program has been funded by the Ministry of Health to begin in early April. Only patients currently receiving palliative home care nursing services from IHA are eligible. This service was designed to support palliative patients to stay at home longer with their families or caregivers, and to die at home if they wish to do so. This Palliative Nursing Call Line is meant to augment the services our existing Family Physicians and Palliative Care Call Group currently provide. Your palliative care patients can also call the Marjorie Willoughby Snowden Hospice House to access after hours advice as well at 250-372-1336. Full information is here.
