Endocrinology

The Thompson Region Division of Family Practice, UBC Okanagan, Interior Health Authority and Shared Care (Partners in Care) are collaborating to prototype telehealth as a viable specialist's referral and education option for our region. The prevalence of diabetes continues to rise and access to specialty services to meet this demand is a challenge within the Interior Health Authority region.

This lack of access to specialty services creates many struggles for family practitioners, patients and their families. In our region, there is a scarcity of Endocrinology service, which results in lengthy wait times, patients having to travel to other communities for service, inability to provide dedicated endocrinology support, and lack of specialty knowledge by family physicians.

We are pleased to announce the Endocrinology Telehealth initiative is now ready. Dr. Charlotte Jones, Endocrinologist in Kelowna is now accepting consultation appointments with physicians, specialists, nurse practitioners and the Kamloops Diabetic Clinic. Consultations will occur by telehealth, videoconference and teleconference in the areas of:

- Youth transition services for type 1 diabetes
- Gestational diabetes
- Complex diabetic patients
