The focus of this 0.5 FTE PHC-LPN position is to provide health and wellness education to clients related to activities of daily living, the prevention of injury, illness, and communicable diseases, and to assist with the coordination of population health programs, for the catchment areas of Gordon Head/Shelbourne and Oak Bay. In addition, the LPN may assist other health providers to plan, implement, and evaluate nursing care delivery, including carrying out diagnostic testing, medication dispensing, procedures, and treatments, within scope.

Required Qualifications:

Registration with BC College of Nurses and Midwives as practicing Licensed Practical Nurse registrant. Three year's related experience, or equivalent combination of education, training, and experience. CPR and First Aid Level I, Certification in Gerontology, Wound training, Chronic Disease Care is an asset
