**Summary of Job Description:**

The Mental Health Worker (MHW) utilizes advanced clinical knowledge to provide clinical practice and interventions relating to intake, assessment, crisis intervention, education, treatment, harm reduction, counselling, and referral for clients experiencing mental health, substance use, and/or concurrent disorder problems, and their caregivers/families. The MHW works collaboratively with the PHC team to plan and deliver mental health / substance use (MHSU) individual and group programs and services to meet the needs of the community, for the catchment areas of Gordon Head/Shelbourne and Oak Bay.

**Required Qualifications:**

Master's Degree in Counselling or Social Work or health-related discipline from an approved post-secondary institution.

Three years experience, with significant understanding of mental health and substance use issues.

Knowledge of applicable legislation, such as the Mental Health Act and the Guardianship Act.

Additional clinical competency courses in mental health and/or substance use conditions are an asset.
