01

Most Common Type

Focuses on direct interaction with a client on an individual level

02

Importance of Social Work

Protects the most vulnerable individuals in many different aspects of their lives; connecting the clients with important resources

Supporting Clients

- Help clients access housing and other social services
- Work with youth and children in foster care, schools, or juvenile detention

04

Supporting Clients

- Help families navigate the complex social services/health care system
- Counsel people with mental health or substance abuse issues, or behavioral disorders
