Highlights



This project focuses on co-designing an optimized care pathway from the Emergency Department back to the community for vulnerable frail elderly populations.

Patients can be discharged safely back home with easily accessible community supports that are trusted by the patients, caregivers, family physicians, and specialists to help avoid crisis visits to the ED or the physician office.

- Provides venue for family physicians, specialists, nurses, allied health professionals, and health authority professionals to come together to find solutions to issues that spread across community and acute settings.
- Supports the development of interdisciplinary care plans.
- Supports caregivers on how to navigate care.
- Supports physicians and patients through an example of team-based care.
