Understanding Your Patient Panel – PSP Panel Assessments

Your EMR is a powerful tool that supports purposeful patient care. Taking a deeper dive into the data may reveal interesting aspects of patient care, charting, billing, or clinical business flow. For example, a panel assessment may provide answers to questions such as: *How many diabetic patients do I have? How many 14050 claims did I make last year? How many do I still need to complete this year?* Currently, Doctors of BC and PSP can provide up to **7 hours of sessional payment** to physicians, and up to 10 hours of payment to MOAs who engage in a formal Panel Assessment work.
