Run to Quit - Smoking Cessation Program - Please share with your patients

Run to Quit is an effective program that coaches tobacco users on how to get active AND quit smoking. Participants are supported by a Quit Coach through a gradual 10-week Learn-to-Run clinic in combination with evidence-based smoking cessation strategies. The program is suitable for non-runners and people with any fitness level.

It is offered in three formats:

- · Do It Yourself: Online program available anytime, anywhere
- · In-person: Training program at select Running Room locations in Spring 2017
