Physician Master Agreement

The BCMA President has announced that the BC Medical Association has concluded negotiations with the BC Provincial Government on a new four-year Physician Master Agreement, which is subject to ratification.

The agreement provides for continued support for the collaborative initiatives of the General Practice Services Committee (GPSC), the Specialist Services Committee (SSC), the Rural Joint Standing Committee and other committees. This means that the funding for the Divisions of Family Practice has been included in the agreement.

For Delta Division it means that we have a four-year funding window to make significant difference in our community of practice. It means that we can seriously get to work on the focus areas that you have identified.

With this renewed confidence the board is looking forward to working with you, the family doctors, and collaboratively with our partners in primary care.

UpToDate - a free service for members

UpToDate™ is now available *free of charge* for members who are included in the calculation for our infrastructure funding. You have access through the member portal of the Delta Division's website.

How to Sign Up for UpToDate™

Step 1

Go to www.divisionsbc.ca/delta and log in by clicking on *member login* at the top right hand corner of the home page screen. If you have forgotten your password click on 'Forgot password' and enter your email address. A new password will be sent to your email address. You then have the option to change the password that was sent to you through the 'My Account' link.

Step 2

Click on the UpToDate™ menu item on the top menu bar. Enter the term you are wishing to search or simply hit search.

Step 3

A screen will appear with both a Log in and a Registration form on it. If you currently hold an UpToDate™ subscription please enter your UpToDate™ user name and password in the **Log in** form and click on the 'Log In' button. You

need to do this one time only and it will ensure that your CME credits are recorded in any reports.

If you are a new user fill in the fields on the Registration form and then click on the 'Submit Registration' button. The registration process is required one time only and enables recording of your CME credits.

What if I am already a subscriber?

To access the member's only portion of the website

Click on *member login* at the top right hand corner of the home page screen.

- Enter your user name, unless you have the set the name for yourself, it is your first initial and surname - no spaces.
- You will be asked for your password.
- If you do not know your password, click forgot password. The system will ask for your e-mail address and will send you a new one.
- Keep your new password safe so that you can have easy access in the future.

Note that the Delta Division has no access to your confidential log-in information.

Member profile - Dr. Art Shier

Dr. Art Shier began general practice in Vancouver in July of 1960 and spent ten years there before commencing his practice in Tsawwassen in August of 1970. He is the longest serving physician in South Delta, with 42 years of medicine in the same location, and 52 years as a family physician.

He recalls the summer he came to Tsawwassen as the year when a Russian freighter, *Sergey Yesenin* collided with the *Queen of Victoria* in Active Pass, slicing through the middle of the ferry and killing three people.

He practiced obstetrics as part of his service until 1985, and has many fond

practice there without requiring a Washington State license. Dr. Shier remembers following an ambulance straight through the border on an emergency without stopping - a far cry from today's situation!

Still in active practice today, participating in on-call, and enjoying every moment of being a family doctor, Dr. Shier serves as an outstanding example of the dedication of a full time general practitioner.
