Nisga'a Valley Health Authority (NVHA) oversees four Health and Wellness facilities located across the Traditional Nisga'a Territory. Located 100 km Northwest of Terrace, bordering British Columbia's rugged Northwest coast, the Nisga'a Lands are blessed with soaring mountains, dramatic lava beds, picturesque fjords, and thriving rivers and crystal-clear streams.

NVHA has established inclusion in the Pacific Northwest Division of Family Practice. Each Health Centre has access to the First Responders program for emergency patient transportation. Three of the facilities have full time clinic/remote practice nurses. Other supports include Public Health Nurse, CDC Nurse, Case Manager, Home Care, Community Health Representatives, and boasts a comprehensive Mental Wellness program hub.

Nisga'a Lisims Government, under 2013 Treaty, has defined rights of law-making authority over lands, interests and citizenship. As Nisga'a Valley Health is funded directly through the Nisga'a Nation, we are perfectly poised to develop comprehensive Wellness services based on the unique needs of our Nation. In the development process, we are able to utilize the principles of Primary Health Care while honoring the timeless holistic Nisga'a Wellness model.

Currently NVHA is in the process of remodeling our Health Care Delivery Service Model and is seeking vibrant, self-motivated and innovative Primary Care Physicians interested in playing an integral part of cutting-edge Indigenous Health Care Programming and Service Delivery (Primary, Urgent and shared on/call Emergency).
