You are invited to contribute to the design of an ICS learning and development resource toolkit in a four hour engagement session.

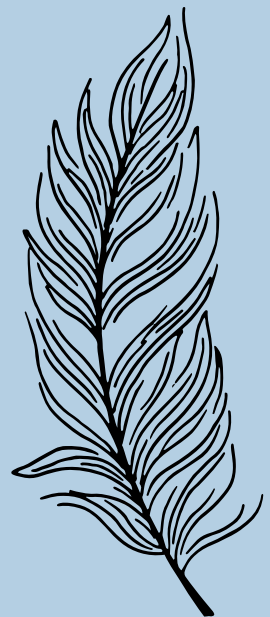
