# **Update on Family Medicine Resident and New to Practice Family Physician Longitudinal Practice Incentives**

#### **Overview of Incentives**

The following incentives are offered to all family medicine residents and NTP FPs who completed their medical residencies in 2021 or 2022:

- \$295,457 NTP contract rate (year two rate of current contact);
- \$25,000 signing bonus;
- \$50,000 loan forgiveness payment; and,
- Potential for additional contributions to loan forgiveness of \$20,000 per year for years two to five.

The incentives will be offered until May 31, 2023. The Ministry of Health will assess over the course of 2022-23 whether the incentives will continue to be offered beyond that date. There are no limits on the availability of NTP service contracts for communities provided that the parties work in good faith to meet the terms of the contracts, particularly the attachment expectations.

#### **Overhead**

In addition to the individual incentives, the Ministry will also provide an overhead contribution of \$75,000 per FTE per year to each clinic hosting a NTP FP under this arrangement. This payment is intended to significantly reduce or in some cases eliminate the amount of overhead the NTP will be required to contribute to their host clinic.
